Top brains at MEPS

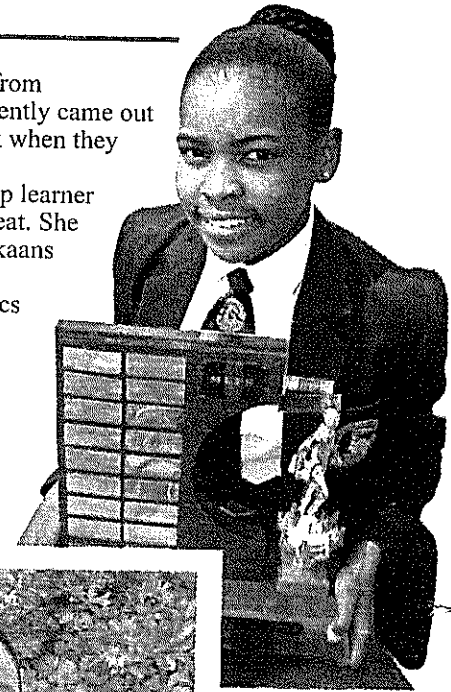
