RULES & REGULATIONS

A. Code of Discipline

The code of Discipline prescribes a set of rules and regulations that guides student behavior in order to create an environment that is conductive to learning and growth.

This code should be followed by the students anytime they are within the school vicinity, during school programs and affairs, and whenever they are wearing their school uniform.

B. Intervention Procedures

Students who do not follow the Code of Discipline will usually be given verbal warnings followed by written disciplinary warnings once the undesired behavior recurs. The parents will be called in to discuss how to work together to improve the child's behavior, if it is a second written warning of the same nature. If the undesired behavior still persists, the school will impose detention, suspension, or expulsion as disciplinary actions. However, the school may reclassify an offence or impose a heavier penalty immediately without going through the sequence of disciplinary actions mentioned, depending on the seriousness of the violation.

Offences are classified into 3 categories: Minor, Major, and Grave. However, these classifications are not absolute. The school may reclassify specific offences on a case to case basis.

C. Minor Offences

Minor offences are those that would first receive a verbal warning and conduct point will be deducted at the discretion of the teacher. Repeatedly doing the same offence would result in written disciplinary warnings and parents will be notified and invited to come for a conference. The following list is not exhaustive; the school may classify other improper behaviors as minor offences.

- 1. Dress code and hairstyle violations
- 2. Late in coming to school or in-between periods
- 3. Excessive talking, playing, standing, walking, or doing things that disrupt classes
- 4. Shouting or making excessive noise in hallways
- 5. Playing rough games
- 6. Running in the hallway or up and down the stairs
- 7. Not following orders or showing disrespect to teacher or staff by answering back, not paying attention, doing other things, or being sarcastic
- 8. Leaving the room without permission
- 9. Hitting, or hurting a classmate
- 10. Using foul I languages or obscene gestures
- 11. Dishonesty
- 12. Cutting classes
- 13. Littering

- 14. Loitering or going to an off-limits area
- 15. Bringing banned items such as trading cards, cell phones, i-pods, etc. (items will be confiscated and may not be returned I may only be returned at the end of the school year)
- 16. Not returning report cards or other school documents on time
- 17. Failure to submit homework
- 18. Teasing

D. Major Offences

Major offences are those that immediately call for a written warning and a meeting with the parents. Detention or suspension may be imposed without any prior warning, depending on the seriousness of the case. The following list is not exhaustive; the school may classify other improper behaviors as major offences.

- 1. Stealing
- 2. Cheating
- 3. Leaving the school premises without permission
- 4. Destroying school property
- 5. Vandalizing
- 6. Threatening, hitting, or hurting students, teachers, staff, or visitors
- 7. Smoking, drinking liquor, or gambling
- 8. Affiliation with fraternities or sororities
- 9. Possession of pornographic materials or cigarettes (they will immediately be confiscated and will not be returned)

E. Grave Offences

Grave offences are offences which are so serious that they call for expulsion

Expulsion is a penalty involving the removal of an undesired student from the school rolls. The student is not allowed to attend classes anymore, but is allowed to transfer to another school.

- 1. Gross misconduct
- 2. Immorality
- 3. Carrying a deadly weapon
- 4. Using, selling, and/or having in possession prohibited drugs
- 5. Assaulting students, teachers, staff, or visitors.

F. Fees/ Payments
